

Blackboard Tool: Learning Modules

Slide 1

If your instructor has chosen to organize your course into unique blocks of instruction, a learning module tool button will show on the Tools menu.

Click on the Learning Modules button to proceed.

Slide 2

A list of the learning modules, or in other words, units of study will appear.

Click on module title, such as Week 5, to view the module content.

Slide 3

The Week 5 module displays a navigational map, comprised of links, on the left hand side of the page.

Click on the appropriate link, either week 5: class 1 or week 5: class 2 in this example, to navigate to the content page for the week.

Slide 4

A click on the link titled Week 5 Class 1 Lab Session reveals the learning objectives and assignments for this class.

Your instructor may include more or less information in this area

Slide 5

Note the plus sign to the left of the Week 5 Class 1 Lab session of this module.

Slide 6

A click on the plus box to the left of the level will expand the level to reveal the related sub-level links for this week of the module.

Note the two new levels denoted as 1.1 and 1.2.

Slide 7

A click on link 1.2, as shown, will open the required reading assessment for the same time period.

A click on the newly displayed link, 1.1, would open the required discussion board posting for class 1 of this week.

Likewise, a click on the initial plus mark to the left of the Week 5 Class 2 Online Session will display the link for the internet based research paper assignment required for class 2 of this week.

Slide 8

Continue to work through a module using this process. Learning modules will assist you in staying on track and working effectively through a unit of study.

Click on the minus signs to the left of the levels to collapse the navigational map as desired.

Slide 9

Return to the Home Page by clicking on the Content Page button on the Course Tool menu.
